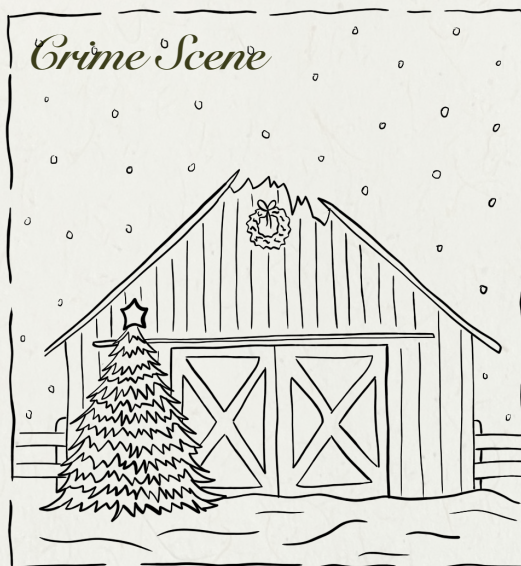


The Sabotage Before Christmas

The evidence points to someone—or something—who could access the roof. Suspicion falls on the reindeer, the only ones capable of reaching such heights. But which reindeer is the culprit...

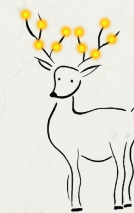

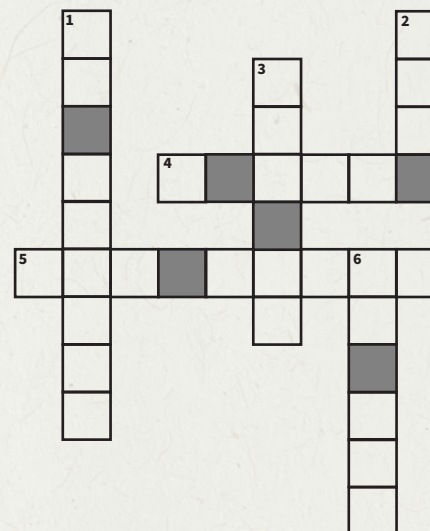
Crossword
